<b>General</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A place to dry your paintings such as a table or washing line</li> <li>A large table or floor space</li> <li>A range of paint brushes</li> <li>A ruler</li> <li>A selection of A4 white printing paper</li> <li>A selection of large sheets of paper, A3 or larger</li> <li>A set of pencils, HB, 2B, 4B</li> <li>Biros or fine line pens</li> <li>Camera or device to photograph artwork</li> <li>Cardboard</li> <li>Coloured paper</li> <li>Colouring pencils</li> <li>Colouring pens</li> <li>Glue stick</li> <li>PVA Glue</li> <li>Scissors</li> <li>Sponges</li> <li>String</li> <li>Sugar paper or textured paper</li> </ul>

<b>Exploring Painting and Colour</b> (Weeks 6 to 12)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cotton buds or chopsticks for painting dots</li> <li>Liquid paints such as gouache or tempera</li> <li>Magazines and collage materials</li> <li>Watercolor paints</li> </ul>
<b>Collage &amp; Mixed Media</b> (Weeks 12 to 18)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A large box or selection of cardboard</li> <li>Felt fabric or other fabric for making finger puppets</li> <li>Lollipop sticks or BBQ sticks</li> <li>Packaging or cereal boxes</li> <li>Sellotape or masking tape</li> </ul>
<b>Printing, Textiles and Materials</b> (Weeks 18 – 24)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A selection of coloured wool, yarn or threads.</li> <li>Block printing paint or acrylic paint</li> <li>Four sticks of equal length</li> <li>Permanent pens</li> </ul>
